Behaviour

Parents/Guardians are fully responsible for the children in their care at all times. While on school property we must adhere to all the school rules and respect each other and everybody's property. First aid

Parking

Please ensure you park your vehicles in bays around the school. Keep verges, pathways, roadways and driveways clear. The ranger frequents the area and will issue fines. See attached map for parking locations around Edgewater primary and overflow at Mater Dei on Pioneer Drive side only. Also be aware public transport operates around our school, so fold your mirrors in. The front staff car park will be kept vacant for drop off/pick up of gear and the coffee van. Police and school security will be patrolling the area during the camp to keep an eye on things.

Planting

If you are available after camp to assist in some planting of seedlings we are seeking some addition tooling. We understand if you have other commitments. The items needed are:

- Watering cans
- Shovel or spade
- Wheel barrow
- Fork (If we have mulch available)

Final Word

You'll need to do a few things with your kids to make this work.

- 1. Get your kids excited about the Camp Over, tell them how much you are looking forward to camping with them
- 2. Pull out the tent, sleeping mats, sleeping bags, an old fry pan, some plastic cups, plates and cutlery, change the batteries in the torches, grab a camping chair
- 3. Talk to your kids about what you should make together for tea Saturday night. Something you can cook on a single burner stove or BBQ. Then go shopping with your kids to buy it and grab a few munchies for when you're in the tent.
- 4. Finally rock up to the school oval from 12pm 22nd May. Knock off early that day to make sure you can pack the car with the kids. They will be excited and will be disappointed if you are late. When you get to school put your tent up together as a family on the oval.
- 5. In the morning enjoy some brekkie together and pack up to depart by 12PM. Remember there will be planting activities from 9am if you're available to stay.
